

Enrolled 358% of the Expected Goal for a US-Based Phase 2 IBS-D Trial

Our Objectives

DelRicht Research was selected as a participating site network for a Phase 2 clinical trial targeting adults with IBS-D. The trial aimed to recruit a broad adult population aged 18 and older.

- **Study Enrollment Goal:** 450 participants across 75 sites
- **DelRicht's Enrollment Goal:** 48 participants across 8 sites
- **Patient Population:** Participants \geq 18 years of age
- **Enrollment Period:** December 2023 – June 2025

Trial Challenges

Two key hurdles emerged during trial execution. Maintaining the \geq 70% diary compliance required for both eligibility and continued participation proved challenging, as falling below this threshold classified participants as non-responders. Equally important was ensuring thorough, consistent education on pain scale anchoring and proper use of the Bristol Stool Scale to support accurate and reliable reporting.

Our Results

DelRicht addressed these challenges through **1) proactive diary compliance tracking** by the data team with **timely re-education for participants**, and **2) effective participant training on the Bristol Stool Scale** using visual tools provided by the study team to ensure accurate, consistent reporting.

DelRicht's 8 sites successfully **enrolled 172 participants, 358% of the expected goal**. Dr. E Marshall Newton was recognized as the **top enroller overall**, with 3 other DelRicht sites ranking among the top 5. Dr. Matthew Mintz **achieved First Patient First Visit (FPFV)** for the trial.

DelRicht's proactive site engagement, strong investigator performance, and commitment to data quality continue to deliver exceptional enrollment outcomes across diverse therapeutic areas.
